Terms of Reference

Background

The NNEdPro Central, Southeast (SE) & East Asia (EA) Regional Network was formed as a research network of academics, dietitians, doctors, researchers across this region who are passionate about providing evidence-based nutrition advice and messages. The mission of this network is to bring together representatives from across the country to facilitate the spread and scale of existing nutrition knowledge, experiences, standards, and research, particularly focused on strengthening of nutrition competence and confidence in the healthcare workforce.

Objectives

- Supports training, research in both clinical & public health nutrition services
- Promotes the exchange of the application of evidence-based nutrition knowledge and focus on harmonization of practices.
- Strengthens the coordination of nutrition research efforts in the region and sharing of best practices in all areas of global, regional and local nutrition and sustainability issues
- Promotes international cultural events targeted around food & customs

Purpose of the Steering Committee

- 1. Provide direction to the Network, including prioritizing tasks, finding and following-up with opportunities, and developing collaborations.
- 2. Provide opportunities for Network members to share ideas and identify new opportunities for promotion of existing nutrition knowledge, experiences, standards, and research.
- 3. Inform the dissemination strategies developed to spread and scale nutrition evidence and standards.
- 4. Promote research collaborations which establish best practice in nutrition for health professionals.

Membership

All members of the Steering Committee are also members of the Central, SE & East Asia Network. Others associated with the Central, SE & East Asia Network are listed as 'Stakeholders', who will be updated on overall activity and invited to attend meetings when relevant.
